July: Divine Shifts

Week 2 – Fighting for our shift

Introduction

The starting point of any divine shift is the will of God. Outside of that, we are not talking of a divinely-mandated shift, but a humanly-manipulated outcome.

However, we do know that there can often be a disconnect between the will of God (in heaven) and our lived reality (on earth) – hence Jesus' guidance to pray "Your kingdom come" and "Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven". We know that God is willing and able to cause a shift to our circumstances. We know that His divine power has given us everything we need to be all that He has called us to be. We have heard the prophetic word, we've seen a vision for a better tomorrow, and our hearts yearn with expectation.

There is a divine shift available for us, but we may not yet have experienced it in full. How do we engage in the place of warfare to ensure that nothing stands in the way of our shift?

1 Tim 1:18 This charge I commit to you, son Timothy, according to the prophecies previously made concerning you, that by them you may wage the good warfare

Eph 6:11-13 Put on the whole armour of God, that you may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. 12For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly places. 13Therefore take up the whole armour of God, that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand.
