## Week 3: From growing to thriving

## Introduction

Growth is a basic expectation of life. But even then life teaches us that growth does not always happen to the same extent, and the outcomes of growth can be dramatically different. Why does a particular plant take over the field ahead of the other plants even though they are all alive, and therefore growing? Why does a particular product or idea enter into a space and overtake others that may have been there ahead of it? In order to truly stand out in our place of purpose, we need to go beyond the basic foundations of growth. We need to thrive.

<u>Psa 1:1-3</u> [AMP] 1[a]Blessed [fortunate, prosperous, and favored by God] is the man who does not walk in the counsel of the wicked [following their advice and example], nor stand in the path of sinners, nor sit [down to rest] in the seat of [b]scoffers (ridiculers). 2But his delight is in the law of the LORD, and on His law [His precepts and teachings] he [habitually] meditates day and night. 3And he will be like a tree firmly planted [and fed] by streams of water, which yields its fruit in its season; its leaf does not wither; and in whatever he does, he prospers [and comes to maturity].
