Week 3 – Managing Money

Introduction

Money is the oil with which our economies are lubricated. Without money, economies grind to a noisy, messy and expensive halt. Just like oil in an engine, for money to do its job properly it needs to flow from one place to another. Oil that that cannot flow is useless as a lubricant. If any engine is to last long and survive whatever life throws at it, the owner must know how to manage its oil. Likewise, in order for any economy - personal, family and collective (such as in a church) - to sustain its wealth, the owners of that economy must know how to manage their money.
