April: Faith under Fire

Week 2

Introduction

A time of testing is often a time of stress, difficulty and pain. But it is also a time of opportunity. When our faith is tested, we have an opportunity to hit the reset button, so that everything that held us back from fulfilling our true potential is burned away by the fire, leaving only that which is imperishable. No wonder the Bible asks us to rejoice when our faith is tried - not because we enjoy the process, but because we see the end goal. There is no better example of this than our Lord Jesus, of whom the Bible says in Heb 12:2 (Good News Translation): Let us keep our eyes fixed on Jesus, on whom our faith depends from beginning to end. He did not give up because of the cross! On the contrary, because of the joy that was waiting for him, he thought nothing of the disgrace of dying on the cross, and he is now seated at the right side of God's throne. We believe that, through faith, we are seated in heavenly places in Christ Jesus. We must also accept that the route to actualising our heavenly position will involve the testing of our faith. But the great news is this – just like Jesus Christ our example, we are guaranteed victory and glory if we can stand firm!

<u>1 Pet 1:6-7</u> In this you greatly rejoice, though now for a little while, if need be, you have been grieved by various trials, that the genuineness of your faith, being much more precious than gold that perishes, though it is tested by fire, may be found to praise, honour, and glory at the revelation of Jesus Christ.

<u>James 1:2-4</u> My brethren, count it all joy when you fall into various trials, knowing that the testing of your faith produces patience. But let patience have its perfect work, that you may be perfect and complete, lacking nothing.
