Introduction

Our faith is our assurance of hope, our conviction of things that are not visible. Hope is what keeps us going through difficult times. There are many people who do not have this assurance, and whose vision is limited to only that which they can see. When we come across such people, we have the opportunity to share our faith with them. It could be the fellow believer struggling with doubt, and sharing our faith helps to rekindle theirs. It could be the questioner looking for answers to life's difficult issues, and sharing our faith could point them towards God. Whatever the case, our faith does not diminish when we share it with others. Instead, just like a small flame could set an entire forest ablaze, so could sharing our faith set our world alight with the fire of revival.
