Introduction

We are all familiar with the idea of “church”. But for many people, church means different things. For some, it is a building where people gather to worship. For others it is the congregation, the act of gathering itself, that is the church. In today’s bible study, we will seek to understand for ourselves who or what the church is, with a special focus on what the bible says about it.
