Week 1 - The case for Restoration

Introduction

Have you ever wished you could turn back the clock, to somehow go back in time? You are not alone. The popular literature and entertainment of most cultures are full of our desire to time travel. A simple internet search of the term "time travel" results in over 5.2 billion hits. Why are we so interested in time travel? There may be many different ways that the answer is expressed, but the end objective is usually the same: to change something in the past in order to affect the future. The main idea is to recover something that was lost - an opportunity, a loved one or wealth. So what does this have to do with restoration? Let's find out!

 - Pre-restoration: How do we know that we need to be restored, and what should we do when we recognise our need? Prov 6:31, Luke 15, Luke 17:12-13
 - In-restoration: What should we be doing as we are being restored? Heb 10:36, Matt
 8:2-3
 - Post-restoration: What should we do afterwards? Luke 17:15-18, Luke 22:32, 2 Cor
 1:3-4, Gal 6:1
- Take home actions
 - Study bible examples of people who experienced restoration. Pay particular attention to Job and David, as we will consider these in the coming weeks.
