

DAY 1 – WEDNESDAY 23RD OCTOBER

THANKSGIVING FOR THE VEIL REMOVED (DIVINE DISCOVERIES)

2 Corinthians 3:14-16 – ¹⁴ But their minds were blinded. For until this day the same veil remains unlifted in the reading of the Old Testament, because the veil is taken away in Christ. ¹⁵ But even to this day, when Moses is read, a veil lies on their heart. ¹⁶ Nevertheless when one turns to the Lord, the veil is taken away.

- Thank God that the veil is removed in Christ Jesus

Eph 2:20 – *“For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them.”*

- Thank God that we are His workmanship and decree that we would indeed walk in them.

1 Cor 12:12-14 – *“Just as a body, though one, has many parts, but all its many parts form one body, so it is with Christ. 13 For we were all baptized by one Spirit so as to form one body—whether Jews or Gentiles, slave or free—and we were all given the one Spirit to drink. 14 Even so the body is not made up of one part but of many.”*

- Thank God that we each are part of His body.
- Pray that each of us will discover our part in the body.

Eph 1:18-19 – *“I pray that the eyes of your heart may be enlightened in order that you may know the hope to which he has called you, the riches of his glorious inheritance in his holy people, 19 and his incomparably great power for us who believe. That power is the same as the mighty strength.”*

- Give thanks for the opening of our eyes. For the opening of eyes gives sight and sight helps us to discover and see.
- Also give thanks because divine discovery helps us to understand God's incomparable power that's at work in our lives.

Matt 5:16 – *“Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven.”*

- Let us give thanks to God as well for letting others discover us. When we are discovered by others, we are able to step into our destiny. E.g., Daniel, David, Esther and Joseph.

1st Pet 2:9 – *“But ye are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an holy nation, a peculiar people; that ye should shew forth the praises of him who hath called you out of darkness into his marvelous light.”*

- Thank God because through His word, we have been able to divinely discover that we are indeed chosen by Him.

Matt 7:7 – “Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you”.

- Thank God for divine discoveries that as we ask we receive, we seek and find and when we knock the door is opened unto us.

DAY 2 – THURSDAY 24TH OCTOBER

FOR THE DISCOVERY OF GOD AND WHO YOU ARE IN GOD

Ephesians 1:16 -19 - “Do not cease to give thanks for you, making mention of you in my prayers: 17 that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give to you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of Him, 18 the eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that you may know what is the hope of His calling, what are the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints, 19 and what is the exceeding greatness of His power toward us who believe, according to the working of His mighty power”.

- Let us start by giving thanks to God for the discovery found in Him and who we are in Him. Our true identity is who God says we are.
- Pray that we all begin to experience the full benefits of the discovery of God and who we are in Him in every area of our lives.

Philippians 2:12 – Not that I have already attained, or am already perfected; but I press on, that I may lay hold of that for which Christ Jesus has also laid hold of me.

- Pray that you would apprehend that for which you were apprehended by God.

Ephesians 1:5 – “Having predestined us to adoption as sons by Jesus Christ to himself, according to the good pleasure of His will”.

Ephesians 2:10 – “For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them.”

- Pray that we will always believe and understand our identity in God, understanding who He is; what He says about Himself and what He says about us.

1 Peter 4:10 – “Each of you should use whatever gift you have received to serve others, as faithful stewards of God’s grace in its various forms”.

Ephesians 3:20 – “Now to Him who is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that works in us.”

- Pray that we will always recognise and find our place in the church and in the world and use our talents, abilities and interests to serve.
- Pray that the London lighthouse will abound exceedingly in the grace, faith and love that is in Christ Jesus, and through His exceeding grace, will become all that God ordained for her.

Hebrews 4:12 – *“For the word of God is living and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and of joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.”*

Psalms 119:105 – *“Your word is a lamp to my feet, and a light to my path.”*

- Let us ask the Lord to help us daily to study and rely on the Bible and use it as a mirror to always understand ourselves and where we need to grow in Him; believing what God says about us and letting it guide and guard us in every area of our lives.

Psalms 84:11 – *“For the Lord God is our sun and our shield. He gives us grace and glory. The Lord will withhold no good thing from those who do what is right.”*

Luke 8:17 – *“For nothing is secret that will not be revealed, nor anything hidden that will not be known and come to light.”*

- Thank God that because of His mercies, grace and favour, we will not only make divine discoveries but will be discovered for good for the rest of the year and ahead in Him in Jesus mighty name.
- Pray that whatever revelation, miracle and truth that has been hidden will be discovered by who we are in Him.

DAY 3 – FRIDAY 25TH OCTOBER

FOR DISCOVERY OF YOUR PURPOSE, POTENTIAL, POWER AND PLACE

Jeremiah 29:11 – *“For I know the plans I have for you,” declares the Lord, “plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future.”*

- Let’s declare that we are led by the Holy Spirit to understand Christ’s plans for us.
- Ask that we are assisted to walk in the path He’s prepared, knowing that His thoughts towards us are of peace, hope, and a future.

Proverbs 19:21 – *“Many are the plans in a person’s heart, but it is the Lord’s purpose that prevails.”*

- Declare that the purpose of our Lord will prevail in our lives, that our hearts and desires align with His will.
- Ask that we know to trust in His wisdom and timing, that we may fulfil the reason for which we are created.

Ephesians 3:20 – “Now to Him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, according to his power that is at work within us.”

- Declare that the hidden potential within us is awoken, and we grow spiritually to realize the great power at work within.
- Pray that our lives will be a testimony of Christ’s extraordinary ability to do more than we can ask or imagine.

Philippians 4:13 – “I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me.”

- Ask that we are empowered to tap into our God-given potential. That we have the boldness and strength we need to step out in faith, knowing that through Christ, we can accomplish all that He has called us to be and do.

Psalms 92:13 – “Those who are planted in the house of the Lord shall flourish in the courts of our God”.

- Decree that we are planted firmly in the place of our calling, that we may flourish in the Lord’s house and be fruitful in every area of our lives, bringing glory to His name in all that we do.

2 Timothy 1:7 – “For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power, love, and a sound mind”.

- Reject every spirit of fear and timidity, instead, we receive the spirit of power, love, and a sound mind. Pray that Christ’s power in us helps us overcome every obstacle as we fulfil our divine assignment.
