

DAY 1 – WEDNESDAY 20TH NOVEMBER

THANKSGIVING FOR THE FINISHED WORK AND VICTORY IN CHRIST

Philippians 1:6 – “Being confident of this, that he who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus.”

1 Corinthians 15:57 – “But thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.”

- Thank God for the finished work and the victory we have in Christ Jesus. Through Him, it has been won and is already done; it is settled. We have received unearned love and favor through God’s goodness.
- Pray that every member of our household and church, House on the Rock, London Lighthouse continues to experience the full benefits of the finished work of Christ in all areas of our lives.

Ephesians 1:7 – “He is so rich in kindness and grace that He purchased our freedom with the blood of His Son and forgave our sins.”

2 Corinthians 6:18 – “And I will be your Father, and you will be my sons and daughters, says the Lord Almighty.”

- Thank God for His divine grace that has brought us redemption and salvation through the blood of Jesus Christ, which speaks on our behalf.
- Thank Him for the grace that has made us sons and daughters, for His word says “And hast made us unto our God kings and priests: and we shall reign on the earth.”

Psalms 130:7 – “O Isreal, hope in the Lord; for with the Lord there is unfailing love. His redemption overflows.”

1 Peter 5:10 – “In His kindness God called you to share in His eternal glory by means of Christ Jesus. So, after you have suffered a little while, He will restore, support and strengthen you, and He will place you on a firm foundation.”

- Pray that every member of the House of the Rock, London lighthouse, continues to walk in the finished work and the victory in Christ over our lives.
- Pray that the redemptive power of Jesus Christ will go before us and perfect all that concerns us.

Galatians 3:13 – “Christ redeemed us from the curse of the law by becoming a curse for us, for it is written: “Cursed is everyone who is hung on a pole.”

Hebrews 10:23 – “Let us hold tightly without wavering to the hope we affirm, for God can be trusted to keep His promise.”

- Thank God for His preservation towards us and for Christ's redemptive work from redeeming us from "the fall".
- Pray that nothing will be able to hold us back from becoming everything that God created and called us to be. His promises for our lives will be fulfilled.

Jeremiah 29:11 - "For I know the plans I have for you, "says the Lord. "They are plans for good and not for disaster, to give you a future and a hope."

- Thank God that His plans for us, to give us a future and hope, are already done and settled.
- Thank God that because of His finished work, our experiences for the rest of the year and beyond will be a testament and testimony of the victory we have obtained in Christ Jesus.

DAY 2 - THURSDAY 21ST NOVEMBER

TO FINISH THE YEAR STRONG

Zechariah 4:8-9 - "Moreover the word of the LORD came unto me, saying, The hands of Zerubbabel have laid the foundation of this house; his hands shall also finish it; and thou shalt know that the LORD of hosts hath sent me unto you."

- Thank God for the year, 2024, our year of redemption. Indeed, it has been a year of redemption on many levels. Thank Him for all the prophetic words He released over our church this year that we have been able to run with.
- Let us pray and ask the Lord for a release of supernatural strength to finish strong. Ask for a baptism in the Spirit of might. Declare that as we approach the end of the calendar year, the finishing anointing comes upon us so that everything God has put in our hands to do will be complete.
- Pray and ask for a release of supernatural speed over the church. Decree that as we wait on the Lord, our strength is renewed, that we mount up with wings like eagles, run without growing weary, and walk without getting tired.
- As has been declared over us in this house, in these last few weeks of the year, when others are saying there is a casting down and are beginning to shut down, we declare that there is an all-round lifting up for us.
- Declare that we will not follow the pattern of this age. Come against the spirit of fear, weariness and fainting that sets in on many at this time of the year. Declare that because our God does not grow weary nor is depleted in strength, we are not weary or tired; instead we receive a new lease of life to finish the year strong.

- Declare that as a church, we go from glory to glory and that our path is like the shining light, and we continue to shine brighter until we reach the perfect day. We go higher and higher in the Lord.
- Thank God for answered prayers.

Support Scripture: *Zechariah 6:12-13; Ezra 6:14-15; Hebrews 12:2, Isaiah 40:28-31; Proverbs 4:18; Job 22:29, Romans 12:1-2.*

DAY 3 – FRIDAY 22ND NOVEMBER

THE SPIRIT OF WISDOM AND REVELATION

James 1:5 - *“If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask of God, who gives to all liberally and without reproach, and it will be given to him.”*

- Let us thank God for His invitation to seek Him for wisdom. We thank God for His desire to give us wisdom liberally.

Ephesians 1: 17-18 - *“that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give to you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of Him, 18 the eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that you may know what is the hope of His calling, what are the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints.”*

- Let us ask the Holy Spirit to remove any veil that obscures our view, so our eyes will be opened to see exactly what our Father wants us to see. Pray for the wisdom to know what to do with what has been revealed to us.

1 Corinthians 1:30 - *“It is because of him that you are in Christ Jesus, who has become for us wisdom from God—that is, our righteousness, holiness and redemption.”*

- Let us ask God for Grace to delight more in the study of His Word, so that we can fully grasp our identity in Christ, allowing His Word to become flesh in and through our lives.

1 John 4:1 - *“Beloved, do not believe every spirit, but test the spirits to see whether they are from God, for many false prophets have gone out into the world.”*

- Let us beseech God for grace, wisdom and discernment to know what is of Him and what is not, ensuring we remain steadfast in His Word of Truth.

Matthew 7:24 - *“Therefore whoever hears these sayings of Mine, and does them, I will liken him to a wise man who built his house on the rock”.*

- Let us ask God for the grace to be both hearers and doers of His Word, so that His wisdom will always be activated in and through us.

Romans 11: 33 – *“Oh, the depth of the riches and wisdom and knowledge of God! How unsearchable are his judgments and how inscrutable his ways”.*

- Let us thank God for the depth of the riches, wisdom and knowledge of God made available to us through Christ Jesus.

DAY 4 – SATURDAY 23RD NOVEMBER

FOR TRUE REVIVAL

Psalm 80:18 – *“Then we will not turn away from you. Revive us and we will pray to you!”*

- Thank God that it is His will for us to be revived, alive and burning with passion, serving Him with zeal as we wait on Him.
- Let us repent where our hearts have stopped following hard after the Lord and declare our wholehearted return to Him. Ask that the Lord will turn our hearts to Him in true repentance as we seek Him.
- Bring your heart to the Lord and ask Him to revive our hearts as a church. Ask Him to give us a new heart that yearns for and follows hard after Him
- Come against the spirit of lukewarmness toward God and the things of God. Ask that the Lord will pour out His Spirit on us as we wait on Him in prayer. Pray that the spirit of grace (prayer) and supplication be poured out upon us as a church.
- Ask for a fresh baptism in the Spirit and decree that as He revives us, our spirits are on fire, bubbling up within us - we are aglow, fervent in the Spirit and full of zeal serving the Lord.
- Declare that as the Lord pours out His Spirit on us, we begin to see an explosion of the workings of the Spirit within and among us as individuals. Declare that as a result of our revival we begin to see the impact in our local communities.
- Thank God for answered prayers.

Support Scriptures: *“Psalms 85:6, Joel 2:28-29, Romans 12:11, Ezekiel 11:19, Malachi 4:6, Revelations 3: 14-22, Psalm 63:8, Zechariah 12:10”*

DAY 5 – SUNDAY 24TH NOVEMBER

FOR KINGDOM ADVANCEMENT

Matthew 11:12a – *“From the days of John the Baptist until the present, the Kingdom of Heaven has been forcefully advancing.”*

Ecclesiastes 8:4 – *“His command is backed by great power. No one can resist or question it”.*

- Let us start by giving thanks to God that the word has gone forth for kingdom advancement; there is great and mighty power in the Word.

Philippians 1:27 – *“Only let your manner of life be worthy of the gospel of Christ”*

Romans 14:17 – *“For the Kingdom of God is not a matter of what we eat or drink, but of living a life of goodness and peace and joy in the Holy Spirit”.*

- Pray that the gospel would be central to all we say and do.
- Pray for an increase of faith, grace, hope and strength for endurance in this life to arise and answer the call of God to advance the purposes of the Kingdom.

2 Thessalonians 1:11-12 – *“To this end we always pray for you, that our God may make you worthy of his calling and may fulfill every resolve for good and every work of faith by his power, 12 so that the name of our Lord Jesus may be glorified”.*

- Pray that God will allow us to fulfill every good work that we resolve to undertake for His glory and the willingness to advance the mandate of the kingdom assignment.

1 Corinthians 13:6 – *“It does not rejoice about injustice but rejoices whenever the truth wins out”.*

Psalms 89:14 – *“Righteousness and justice are the foundation of your throne. Unfailing love and truth walk before you as attendants”.*

- Pray for kingdom intervention and manifestation wherever injustice is found. Love takes no pleasure in injustice but rejoices in the truth.
- Pray for the divine establishment of justice in our nation.

Acts 1:8 – *“But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witness in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the earth”.*

- Pray that we make manifest the kingdom of God live according to His will in our homes, the church, communities, nations, and the land.
- Pray that we shall receive power to be witnesses to wherever He has placed us.

Mathew 16:18 – *“Now I say to you that you are Peter (which means ‘rock’), and upon this rock I will build my church, and all the powers of hell will not conquer it”.*

- Just as Christ has built up His church as the vanguard of God’s kingdom here on earth, let us declare that no entity or force of darkness will prevail against the advancement of the kingdom of God.
- Jesus, the master builder of the church, let us pray that House on the Rock, London Lighthouse, begins to experience explosive growth this year and beyond.

DAY 6 – MONDAY 25TH NOVEMBER

FOR GODLY LEADERSHIP AND OUR LEADERS

Isaiah 30:21 – *“And your ears shall hear a word behind you, saying, ‘This is the way, walk in it,’ when you turn to the right or when you turn to the left”.*

- Declare that our leaders are granted discernment in their decisions and insight into the word of God. May they lead with hearts attuned to His voice, understanding the deep mysteries of faith.

James 1:5 – *“If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask of God, who gives to all liberally and without reproach, and it will be given to him”.*

- Pray that our leaders are filled with the knowledge of God’s will in all spiritual wisdom and understanding, so they may walk in a manner worthy of Him, bearing fruit in every good work.

Mark 10:45 – *“For even the Son of Man came not to be served but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many”.*

- Pray that our leaders will embody the heart of a servant, as exemplified by Jesus Christ. May our leaders prioritize the needs of those they serve, demonstrating compassion and humility. Ask the Lord to teach them to listen and respond to the concerns of the people, fostering a culture of love and respect.

Joshua 1:9 – *“Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged, for the LORD your God will be with you wherever you go”.*

- Just as the Lord commanded Joshua, pray that our leaders will be strong and courageous, unafraid to stand for truth and proclaim the gospel. In times of challenge, may they be reminded that God is with them wherever they go.
- Declare that they are empowered to face opposition with grace and to speak His truth with love, encouraging the congregation to stand firm in their faith. Hallelujah! Amen.

Psalm 121:7-8 – *“The LORD will keep you from all harm; He will watch over your life; the LORD will watch over your coming and going both now and forevermore”.*

- Ask that our leaders are surrounded by angels from above, providing peace in their hearts and safety in their ministry. Pray that they will always feel the presence of our Lord with them, knowing they are shielded by His love as they shepherd the flock. Amen.

DAY 7 – TUESDAY 26TH NOVEMBER

PRAYERS FOR DIVINE DIRECTION, FAVOR & PROSPERITY

Ephesians 1:16-18: *“...The eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that you may know what is the hope of His calling.....”*

- Thank God for the opportunity to know Him and for enlightening you.
- Pray that God continues to enlighten your eyes and divinely guide you to know the hope to which He has called you.

Psalm 102:13 – *“You will arise and have mercy on Zion; for the time to favor her, yes, the set time, has come.”*

- Decree and declare that there will be a change in circumstances through God’s mercy and compassion towards us. Decree that this is your designated and appointed moment of divine favor.

Psalm 5:12 – *“For You, O Lord, will bless the righteous; with favor, You will surround him as with a shield.”*

- Decree and declare that the blessing of God will activate a shield of favor around your life as you remain in the right standing with God.

Psalm 71:02-2 – *“You, who have shown me great and severe troubles, shall revive me again, And bring me up again from the depths of the earth. You shall increase my greatness, and comfort me on ever side.”*

- Pray that God will work through all your circumstances and use them to increase your greatness and honor for His name’s sake.

2 Kings 18:7 – *“The Lord was with him; he prospered wherever he went. And he rebelled against the king of Assyria and did not serve him”.*

- Decree and declare that as the Almighty remains with you, you will prosper wherever you go according to God’s promises to you in His Word.
- Thank God for answered prayers and granting you divine direction, favor and prosperity.

DAY 8 – WEDNESDAY 27TH NOVEMBER

MIRACLES, SIGNS & WONDERS

Isaiah 8:18(AMPC)- *“Behold, I and the children whom the Lord has given me are [a] signs and wonders [that are to take place] in Israel from the Lord of hosts, Who dwells on Mount Zion.”*

- Let’s thank God for making us signs and wonders because when the world sees us, they see Christ.
- Ask God to open our eyes to see that we are already signs and wonders, regardless of what our circumstances may suggest.

Mark 9:23 (NKJV) – *“Jesus said to him, “If [a] you can believe, all things are possible to him who believes.”*

- Pray that God would help us believe that we can experience the miraculous and our lives can be a sign and wonder.
- Let’s pray that God would help us believe that He can use us as vessels for others to experience the miraculous.

Hebrews 2:4 (AMP)- *“[and besides this evidence] God also testifying with them [confirming the message of salvation], both by signs and wonders and by various miracles [carried out by Jesus and the apostles] and by [granting to believers the] gifts of the Holy Spirit according to His own will.”*

- Let's pray that God would demonstrate the power of salvation through our lives with miraculous signs and wonders for the glory of His name.
- Pray that God would make these miracles a lifestyle but also help us stay grateful.

Mark 16:17-18 (AMP)- *"These signs will accompany those who have believed: in My name they will cast out demons, they will speak in new tongues; 18 they will pick up serpents, and if they drink anything deadly, it will not hurt them; they will lay hands on the sick, and they will get well."*

- Let's pray that God would use us as a vessel for the world to experience the miraculous.
- Pray that when people begin to experience miracles through Christ in us, God should give us the grace to remain humble and always point the world to Christ.

DAY 9 – THURSDAY 28TH NOVEMBER

SPIRITUAL WARFARE AGAINST ALL THE PLANS OF THE ENEMY

Rom 8:28 – *"And we know that all things work together for good to those who love God, to those who are the called according to His purpose."*

- Let us thank the Lord because we confidently trust that everything works together to our advantage because we are called and work in accordance with God's own purpose.

Jer 29:11 – *"For I know the plans and thoughts that I have for you," says the Lord, "plans for peace and well-being and not for disaster, to give you a future and a hope."*

Prov 18:20-21 – *"A man's stomach shall be satisfied from the fruit of his mouth; From the produce of his lips he shall be filled. [21] Death and life are in the power of the tongue, And those who love it will eat its fruit."*

- Ask the Lord to grant you the aid to consistently speak His plan into existence and to speak against the plan of the enemy through prayers.

Luke 10:18-19 – *"He said to them, "I watched Satan fall from heaven like [a flash of] lightning. [19] Listen carefully: I have given you authority [that you now possess] to tread on serpents and scorpions, and [the ability to exercise authority] over all the power of the enemy (Satan); and nothing will [in any way] harm you. [0] Nonetheless do not rejoice at this, that the spirits are subject to you."*

- By the power bestowed upon us from heaven, let us take authority over every tactic of the defeated enemy who seeks to destroy marriages, health, finances, businesses, careers, God-given assignments, your children, divine relationships, and spiritual growth.

Gen 1:1-2 – “[1] In the beginning God (prepared, formed, fashioned, and) created the heavens and the earth. [Heb. 11:3.] [2] The earth was without form and an empty waste, and darkness was upon the face of the very great deep. The Spirit of God was moving (hovering, brooding) over the face of the waters.”

- Ask the Holy Spirit to bring resolution to challenging situations, stubborn and addictive behaviours, draining toxic relationships, your children’s challenges, difficult phases, in your marriage, and problematic leaders or managers.

1st Pet 5:8 – “Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour”.

Psalms 119:98 – “Thou through thy commandments hast made me wiser than mine enemies: For they are ever with me.”

- Let us pray that the Lord will grant us wisdom that makes us wiser and more vigilant than the enemy, enabling us to overcome every move he makes to sabotage our plans.

Eph 6:11-12 – “Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. [12] For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.”

- Ask the Lord to help us to continually watch and pray, in order to withstand every strategy of the enemy that seeks to lure us away from God-given plans, promptings, instructions, premonitions, through failures, disappointments, divisions, discouragements, unforgiveness, enemy whispers and recommendations.

DAY 10 – FRIDAY 29TH NOVEMBER

PROPHETIC THANKSGIVING FOR THE YEAR AHEAD

Hebrews 13:15 – “By Him therefore let us offer the sacrifice of praise to God continually, that is, the fruit of our lips giving thanks to His name.”

Psalms 30:12 – “That my heart may sing your praises and not be silent. LORD my God, I will praise you forever.”

- Let us thank God because as we enter 2025, we do so with thanksgiving throughout the year. In the coming year 2025, everyday will be a day of giving thanks to God, both as individuals and as a community. We will give thanks continually and not be silent.

Phil 4:19 – *“But my God shall supply all your needs according to his riches in glory by Christ Jesus.”*

Psalm 1:3 – *“And he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that bringeth forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither; and whatsoever he doeth shall prosper.”*

Psalm 92:13 – *“Those who are planted in the house of the Lord shall flourish in the courts of our God.”*

- In the coming year 2025, let’s give thanks because God has already gone ahead of us to make it pleasant. We are like trees planted by the waterside, constantly provided for in and out of season; therefore, we do not know lack. We give thanks in advance for God’s provision for us in 2025.

Rev 12:11 – *“And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony; and they loved not their lives unto death.”*

- Thank God that in 2025, we will stand as overcomers in all that we do. We will fail in nothing but excel and exceed in all things throughout the year. We will walk and live in victory in 2025, possessing a godly mindset of always winning and succeeding.

Exodus 13:21 vs 22 – *“By day the LORD went ahead of them in a pillar of cloud to guide them on their way and by night in a pillar of fire to give them light, so that they could travel by day or night. 22 Neither the pillar of cloud by day nor the pillar of fire by night left its place in front of the people.”*

- God has already gone ahead of us in 2025. Even before we enter the year, we thank God for His year-round protection over our young, old, and loved ones.

2 Tim 3: 16 vs 17 – *“All Scripture is breathed out by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness, that the man of God may be complete, equipped for every good work.”*

Luke 11:28 – *“But he said, “Blessed rather are those who hear the word of God and keep it!”*

- We speak into the year 2025 that we will always give thanks daily because the word of God finds expression in our lives as we hear, study, and act according to

its commands. God's word will be manifest in our lives throughout the coming year, and all will see that we are truly Christ-like.

2 Pet 3:18 – *“but grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. To Him be the glory, both now and to the day of eternity. Amen.”*

Acts 16:5 – *“So the churches were being strengthened in the faith, and were increasing in number daily.”*

- Pray and give thanks to God for the growth we will experience as a body in Christ. Let us be grateful for our spiritual and physical growth as a church and for new additions to families within our congregation in 2025.

Luke 2:52 – *“And Jesus grew in wisdom and stature, and in favor with God and man.”*

1 Sam 2:26 – *“And the boy Samuel continued to grow in stature and in favor with the LORD and with people.”*

- Thank God in advance for causing us to grow in stature and favor in 2025. That none of us will lack wisdom, but rather He will bestow upon us His good and godly wisdom, helping us to know what to say and do at all times.

Heb 4:16 – *“Let us then approach God's throne of grace with confidence, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help us in our time of need.”*

- We thank God for the exceeding grace He has already provided for us in 2025, enabling us to walk in the abundance of this grace daily without fail in the year ahead. Let us also thank God for the mercy that has gone ahead of us in 2025.
