

PUSH, February 2026 Prayer Points

DAY 1 – WEDNESDAY 25TH FEBRUARY

PRAYER FOR RESTORATION OF RELATIONSHIP WITH GOD (DEEPER WALK WITH GOD).

Psalm 103:1-5 – *“Bless the Lord, O my soul... who forgiveth all thine iniquities; who healeth all thy diseases; who redeemeth thy life from destruction...”*

Lamentations 3:22-23 – *“It is of the Lord's mercies that we are not consumed, because his compassions fail not. They are new every morning: great is thy faithfulness.”*

- Thank God for the gift of salvation and for calling us into relationship with Him. Bless Him for His unfailing love that never gives up on us even when we drift.
- Thank Him for His mercy that restores, His grace that covers, and His patience that draws us back when we wander. Appreciate Him for every time He corrected us in love and for every opportunity to return to His presence.

James 4:8 – *“Draw nigh to God, and he will draw nigh to you. Cleanse your hands, ye sinners; and purify your hearts, ye double minded.”*

- Pray for a renewed hunger and thirst for God in this season. Ask the Lord to remove distractions and complacency as you draw closer to him. Pray that every barrier that has weakened your intimacy with God be broken.
- Ask for the grace to seek Him consistently in prayer, in worship, and in the Word. Declare that your heart will pursue God above every other pursuit. Pray that your desire for Him will be stronger than your desire for success, recognition, or comfort.

Jeremiah 24:7 – *“And I will give them a heart to know me, that I am the Lord: and they shall be my people, and I will be their God: for they shall return unto me with their whole heart.”*

- Pray for a transformed heart that truly knows God. Ask the Holy Spirit to soften every hardened place and purify every part of your heart. Pray for deeper revelation of God's character.
- Declare that your relationship with God will move from religion to a place of strong intimacy with him. Ask that the knowledge of God will shape your decisions and your lifestyle.

Ezekiel 36: 26-27 – *“A new heart also will I give you, and a new spirit will I put within you: and I will take away the stony heart out of your flesh, and I will give you a heart of flesh. And I will put my spirit within you, and cause you to walk in my statutes, and ye shall keep my judgments, and do them.”*

- Pray for renewal of your spirit and alignment with God's will. Ask for fresh fire, fresh oil, and renewed passion for His presence. Pray that the Holy Spirit will convict, correct, and guide you daily. Ask for sensitivity to the Spirit and obedience to God's divine promptings. Pray that your life reflects Christ more clearly in character, speech and conduct.

DAY 2 – THURSDAY 26TH FEBRUARY

RESTORATION OF RELATIONSHIPS WITH ONE ANOTHER (FOR A LOVE WALK WITH ONE ANOTHER)

Psalm 133:1 (KJV) "Behold, how good and how pleasant it is for brethren to dwell together in unity!"

- Pray and thank God for the gift of fellowship with family, the body of Christ and the blessing of community.
- Pray that unity will become the testimony of every relationship within our homes, the church, our workplaces and wider community.

John 13:34–35 (NKJV) "A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another; as I have loved you, that you also love one another. 35 By this all will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another."

- Ask the Lord to reveal areas where you have failed to walk in love and help you to align yourself with His original design.
- Pray that your relationships will reflect Christ to those around and they will see The Christ in you.
- Ask God to make you a true representative of His love in your family, church, workplace and community.

Psalm 139:23–24 (NIV) "Search me, O God, and know my heart; Try me, and know my anxieties; 24 And see if there is any wicked way in me, And lead me in the way everlasting."

- Pray that God will expose pride, offense, bitterness, or unforgiveness in your heart and give you the humility to acknowledge your own faults.
- Pray for grace to take responsibility where you have contributed to broken relationships.
- Ask God to purify your motives in every relationship going forward.

John 13:34–35 (NIV) "A new command I give you: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another. By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another."

- Ask the Lord to remove selfishness, pride, arrogance and indifference from us and our relationships and pour into our hearts Christ love.
- Pray that our love for one another will be a visible testimony to those around us and the world.

Colossians 3:13 (NIV) "Bear with each other and forgive one another if any of you has a grievance against someone. Forgive as the Lord forgave you."

Ephesians 4:31–32 (NIV) "Get rid of all bitterness, rage and anger, brawling and slander, along with every form of malice. Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave."

- Pray for God to cleanse and renew your heart from every anger, rage or unforgiveness that may still be lingering.
- Pray for a new lens to see men as Christ sees men, from the inside out and not from the outside in.
- Pray that you will no longer be a slave to negative thoughts and emotions that keep you bound in unforgiveness.

2 **Corinthians 13:11 (NIV)** "Finally, brothers and sisters, rejoice! Strive for full restoration, encourage one another, be of one mind, live in peace. And the God of love and peace will be with you."

- Pray that God will bring full restoration to every broken Godly relationship in your life.
- Pray for grace to encourage rather than criticize others.
- Ask God to help you live in humility and unity with those around you.
- Pray that the God of love and peace will dwell richly in your home, church, friendships, and workplace.
- Ask the Holy Spirit to empower you to be a peacemaker wherever there is tension or division.

DAY 3 – FRIDAY 27TH FEBRUARY

DEALING WITH ALL OBSTACLES TO RESTORATION (FOR RESTORATION IN EVERY AREA)

Such a large crowd of witnesses is all around us! So, we must get rid of everything that slows us down, especially the sin that just won't let go. And we must be determined to run the race that is ahead of us (Hebrews 12:1)

"I will repay you for the years the locusts have eaten— the great locust and the young locust, the other locusts and the locust swarm (Joel 2:25)

- Thank God for absolute and full restoration He has given us already
- Thank Him for removing already obstacles or hindrances to restoration
- Pray that by His Spirit of Truth we would see every obstacle in our lives that has been a hindrance to restoration.

Proverbs 2:6 "For the LORD gives wisdom: Out of his mouth comes knowledge and understanding."

- Pray that God would give us the grace to identify and get rid of every character, routine, relationship etc that is preventing us from moving forward

Proverbs 6:30-31 "Men do not despise a thief, if he steals to satisfy his soul when he is hungry; But if he be found, he shall restore sevenfold; He shall give all the substance of his house."

- Thank God that the master thief and liar, Satan has already been caught and defeated by Jesus so sevenfold restoration is ours.
- Decree that every thief attempt to steal our blessings or block our restoration be caught and declare sevenfold restoration.
- Ask God to help us not only be sensitive to the promptings and leadings of the Holy Spirit but also give us grace to submit and obey absolutely to experience restoration

John 8:12 "Then spoke Jesus again unto them, saying, I am the light of the world: he that follows me shall not walk in darkness, but shall have the light of life."

- Decree that we would not walk in darkness hiding our restoration from us.
- Declare that we walk in the light of total restoration.

Job 5:12 "He frustrates the devices of the crafty, so that their hands cannot carry out their plans."

- Declare that every device of the enemy and crafty plan to deny you restoration would not work.
- Let's Decree and Declare that every attempt of the enemy to prevent us from experiencing restoration is frustrated.

1 Peter 5:10 “But may the God of all grace, who called us to His eternal glory by Christ Jesus, after you have suffered a while, perfect, establish, strengthen, and settle you.”

- Decree that we are perfected, established, strengthened and settled.
- Declare total settlement and complete restoration
