AWAKENING THE PROPHETIC EAR & GRACE FOR PRAYER

1. Awakening the Ear to Hear God

Isaiah 50:4b–5 – “He wakens me morning by morning, wakens my ear to listen like one being instructed. The Sovereign Lord has opened my ears; I have not been rebellious; I have not turned away.”

- Let us pray that the Lord awakens our spiritual ears **morning by morning**, before the noise of the world rises.
- Declare that God is tuning our spirits to recognize His voice clearly.
- Pray that our hearts remain **tender, obedient, and responsive**, so that we do not resist or turn away from what the Lord speaks.

2. Grace to Hear What the Spirit is Saying

Revelation 2:7 – “Whoever has ears, let them hear what the Spirit says to the churches.”

1 Samuel 3:10 – “Speak, Lord, for your servant hears.”

- Let us declare that our spiritual ears are **sharpened and discerning**, able to distinguish the voice of God from the noise of this age.
- Pray that we will be counted among those who truly **hear what the Spirit is saying to the Church**.
- Like Samuel, may our immediate response always be: **“Speak, Lord, for Your servant hears.”**

3. Breaking Spiritual Deafness and Prayerlessness

Isaiah 50:4b – “He awakened my ear to hear as the learned.”

- Declare that every veil that hinders intimacy with God is torn away.

Isaiah 50:4a – “The Sovereign Lord has given me a well-instructed tongue, to know the word that sustains the weary.”

- Pray that God joins our **prophetic ear and prophetic tongue** together.
- As we hear from Him, we will speak with wisdom, authority, and words that **strengthen and sustain the weary**.

5. The Spirit of Grace and Supplication

Zechariah 12:10 – “I will pour out... a spirit of grace and supplication.”

- Let us pray that our lives become saturated with the **Spirit of grace and supplication**.
- Declare that prayer will no longer feel forced or mechanical, but will flow naturally from within us.
- Ask that intercession becomes **our lifestyle, not merely our discipline**.

6. A People Who Hear, Obey, and Overcome

Revelation 2:7 – “To the one who overcomes, I will give the right to eat from the tree of life.”

- Let us establish that our prayer lives will not be performances but **authentic pursuits of God’s presence**.
- Pray that the Lord raises us as a people who **hear His voice, obey His word, and persevere in prayer**.

Tuesday 17th March 2026
DIVINE ALIGNMENT WITH GOD’S AGENDA

1. Thanking God for His Perfect Plan

Jeremiah 29:11 – “For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, says the Lord, thoughts of peace and not of evil, to give you a future and a hope.”

- Let us thank God for His **good and perfect plans** for our lives.

Sunday 22 March 2026 DECLARING A NEW SEASON OVER THE CHURCH

- Pray that people from every background will be drawn to the light of Christ through the Church. Ask that the influence and reach of the Church will increase greatly.

Psalms 126:1-3 - When the Lord turned again the captivity of Zion, we were like them that dream. Then was our mouth filled with laughter, and our tongue with singing: then said they among the heathen, The Lord hath done great things for them. The Lord hath done great things for us; whereof we are glad.

- Thank God for the new season He has declared over the Church.
- Thank Him because the new thing He has spoken will surely come to pass. Appreciate Him for the testimonies, growth, and breakthroughs that will manifest in this season.
- Thank Him because His plans for the Church are good and full of glory. Celebrate Him because this new season will bring joy, fruitfulness, and fulfilment of His promises.

Monday 23rd March 2026

PULLING DOWN STRONGHOLDS OF THE MIND

2 Corinthians 10:3-5 "For though we live in the world, we do not wage war as the world does. 4 The weapons we fight with are not the weapons of the world. On the contrary, they have divine power to demolish strongholds. 5 We demolish arguments and every pretension that sets itself up against the knowledge of God, and we take captive every thought to make it obedient to Christ."

- Thank God for the powerful weapon He has given us to pull down every stronghold of the Mind that's not Christ.

1 Corinthians 2:16 "For who hath known the mind of the Lord, that he may instruct him? But we have the mind of Christ."

2 Corinthians 10:3-5 "For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war after the flesh: (for the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds;) casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalted itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;"

- Declare that the Mind Of Christ would be the framework and foundation that would govern our perception to life.

Tuesday 24th March 2026
BREAKING GENERATIONAL PATTERNS & CYCLES

Isaiah 43:18-19 "Do not remember the former things, Nor consider the things of old. [19] Behold, I will do a new thing, Now it shall spring forth; Shall you not know it? I will even make a road in the wilderness, and rivers in the desert.

- Thank God for the gift of salvation through Jesus Christ.
- Declare that according to God's Word, everyone who is in Christ is a new creation.
- Thank Him because our identity is no longer defined by our past, our background, or the limitations of our family history.
- Declare that old things have passed away and that all things have become new through Christ.
- Affirm that we now stand in the new life Christ has given us, and declare that every old pattern, habit, and limitation connected to our past is broken in Jesus' name.

2 Corinthians 5:17 "Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new."

Isaiah 43:18-19 "Remember ye not the former things, neither consider the things of old. Behold, I will do a new thing; now it shall spring forth; shall ye not know it? I will even make a way in the wilderness, and rivers in the desert."

Romans 6:4 "Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life."

Colossians 2:14-15 having wiped out the handwriting of requirements that was against us, which was contrary to us. And He has taken it out of the way, having nailed it to the cross. Having disarmed principalities and powers, He made a public spectacle of them, triumphing over them in it.

- Thank God because Jesus Christ became a curse for us so that we might receive the blessing of Abraham.
- Declare that by the power of the cross, every generational curse, inherited bondage, and negative pattern operating in our family lines is broken.

- Affirm that every spiritual burden passed down through generations has no authority over our lives because Christ has redeemed us.
- Receive the blessings of God and declare freedom over our lives and over our families in Jesus' name.

Isaiah 10:27 "It shall come to pass in that day that his burden will be taken away from your shoulder, and his yoke from your neck, and the yoke will be destroyed because of the anointing oil."

Galatians 3:13–14, "that the blessing of Abraham might come on the Gentiles through Jesus Christ; that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith."

Colossians 2:14-15 "blotting out the handwriting of ordinances that was against us, which was contrary to us, and took it out of the way, nailing it to his cross; and having spoiled principalities and powers, he made a shew of them openly, triumphing over them in it."

Numbers 23:23 "Surely there is no enchantment against Jacob, neither is there any divination against Israel: According to this time it shall be said of Jacob and of Israel, what hath God wrought!"

- Declare in the name of Jesus that every cycle of failure, delay, struggle, and disappointment that has repeated itself in our family lines is broken.
- Pray that every pattern of poverty, broken relationships, sickness, and spiritual stagnation passed from one generation to another must stop.
- Declare by the power of God that these cycles are broken today, and affirm that affliction will not rise again.

Psalms 112:1-2 "Praise the Lord! Blessed is the man who fears the Lord, who delights greatly in His commandments. His descendants will be mighty on earth; The generation of the upright will be blessed."

Nahum 1:9 "What do ye imagine against the LORD? he will make an utter end: affliction shall not rise up the second time."

Ezekiel 18:2-4 "What mean ye, that ye use this proverb concerning the land of Israel, saying, the fathers have eaten sour grapes, and the children's teeth are set on edge? As I live, saith the Lord GOD, ye shall not have occasion any more to use this proverb in Israel. Behold, all souls are mine; as the soul of the father, so also the soul of the son is mine: the soul that sinneth, it shall die."

Isaiah 10:27 "And it shall come to pass in that day, that his burden shall be taken away from off thy shoulder, and his yoke from off thy neck, and the yoke shall be destroyed because of the anointing."

- Pray that our lives will mark the beginning of a new and godly legacy in our families.
- Ask the Lord to let righteousness, faith, obedience, and the fear of the Lord flow through our lives to the next generation.
- Declare that our children and the generations after us will walk in the blessings and promises of God.
- Pray that our family lines will be known for serving the Lord and walking faithfully in His purpose.

Isaiah 58:12 “Those from among you shall build the old waste places; You shall raise up the foundations of many generations; And you shall be called the Repairer of the Breach, The Restorer of Streets to Dwell In.”

Deuteronomy 7:9 “Know therefore that the LORD thy God, he is God, the faithful God, which keepeth covenant and mercy with them that love him and keep his commandments to a thousand generations;”

Psalms 112:1-2 “Praise ye the LORD. Blessed is the man that feareth the LORD, that delighteth greatly in his commandments. His seed shall be mighty upon earth: The generation of the upright shall be blessed.”

- Pray for God’s healing over every broken area in our family foundations.

- Pray that God’s mercy will rewrite the story of our families and establish His divine purpose across our generations.

Wednesday 25th March 2026
WARFARE AGAINST DELAY & STAGNATION

Daniel 10:12-13 - Then said he unto me, Fear not, Daniel: for from the first day that thou didst set thine heart to understand, and to chasten thyself before thy God, thy words were heard, and I am come for thy words. But the prince of the kingdom of Persia withstood me one and twenty days: but, lo, Michael, one of the chief princes, came to help me; and I remained there with the kings of Persia.

1 Corinthians 15:57 But thanks be to God, which giveth us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.

Ephesians 5:20 - Giving thanks always for all things unto God and the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ.

- Thank God for the battle that is already won in Jesus Christ, as we declare and pray to move from victory to victory.
- Thank Him for the victory we have in Him through our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.
- Thank God that no matter the situation and circumstance, we have already overcome.

1 John 5:4-5 - For whatsoever is born of God overcometh the world: and this is the victory that overcometh the world, even our faith. Who is he that overcometh the world, but he that believeth that Jesus is the Son of God?.

- Let's pray and come against any power of darkness that seeks to resist us in the place of prayer, as we declare that because all authority and power have been given to us, all powers militating and challenging our prayers bow to us in the name of Jesus.
- Let's release the judgment of God against the power of darkness responsible for delaying the answers to our prayers.
- Command every obstacle to be removed now in the name of Jesus, and eject all forms of stagnation and delay and ask that the angels of God be deployed on our behalf.

Ephesians 6:12 - For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.

- Pray and command every answer to our prayers that has been held up to be released in the name of Jesus
- Let's speak to every form of delay or stagnant situation or circumstance and command it to give way and conform to the word of God- Pray and release the judgment of God against the powers sponsoring delay and stagnancy in our lives.
- Declare and decree that there will be no more delay in this year of Godspeed, as we will experience as a people and as a church, accelerated answers to longstanding issues.
- Declare that we will experience accelerated progress, where once we had experienced stagnation in Jesus mighty name.

Amos 9:13(MSG) – "Yes indeed, it won't be long now." GOD's Decree. "Things are going to happen so fast your head will swim, one thing fast on the heels of the other. You won't be able to keep up. Everything will be happening at once—and everywhere you look, blessings! Blessings like wine pouring off the mountains and hills.

**Thursday 26th March 2026
SILENCING THE ACCUSER**

"No weapon that is formed against thee shall prosper; and every tongue that shall rise against thee in judgment thou shalt condemn." — Isaiah 54:17

"For the accuser of our brethren is cast down... And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony." — Revelation 12:10–11

- Let us begin by thanking God for the victory we have in Christ Jesus.
- Thank Him because through the finished work of the cross, every accusation of the enemy has been silenced, and our righteousness is secured in Him.

Colossians 2:14-15 "blotting out the handwriting of ordinances that was against us, which was contrary to us, and took it out of the way, nailing it to his cross; and having spoiled principalities and powers, he made a shew of them openly, triumphing over them in it."

- Let us declare that every voice of accusation speaking against our lives, families, and destiny is silenced by the authority of the name of Jesus. According to the Word of God, every tongue that rises in judgment against us is condemned.

Isaiah 54:17 "No weapon that is formed against thee shall prosper; and every tongue that shall rise against thee in judgment thou shalt condemn. This is the heritage of the servants of the LORD, and their righteousness is of me, saith the LORD."

- Pray that the blood of Jesus speaks better things over our lives than any accusation, failure, or past mistake.
- Declare that the blood of the Lamb cancels every legal ground the enemy seeks to use against us.

Hebrews 12:24 "and to Jesus the mediator of the new covenant, and to the blood of sprinkling, that speaks better things than that of Abel."

- Ask the Lord to destroy every weapon of condemnation, shame, guilt, and discouragement that the enemy uses to weaken our faith and confidence in God.

Romans 8:1 "There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit."

- Pray that the Holy Spirit will continually remind us of our identity in Christ so that we walk boldly as sons and daughters of God without fear or condemnation.

Galatians 4:6-7 "And because ye are sons, God hath sent forth the Spirit of his Son into your hearts, crying, Abba, Father. Wherefore thou art no more a servant, but a son; and if a son, then an heir of God through Christ."

- Declare that every courtroom of accusation in the spirit realm is overturned by the blood of Jesus. Every demonic verdict and satanic allegation is nullified and cancelled.

Revelation 12:10-11 "And I heard a loud voice saying in heaven, now is come salvation, and strength, and the kingdom of our God, and the power of his Christ: for the accuser of our brethren is cast down, which accused them before our God, day and night. And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony; and they loved not their lives unto the death."

- Pray that the testimony of Christ in our lives will grow stronger and louder than every accusation of the enemy.

Psalms 107:2 "Let the redeemed of the LORD say so, whom he hath redeemed from the hand of the enemy;"

- Decree that every scheme of the accuser against our church, families, and destiny is permanently defeated, and we overcome daily by the blood of the Lamb and the word of our testimony.

Luke 10:19 "Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you."

- Thank God for the victory and authority we have in Christ Jesus.

Friday 27th March

UPROOTING THE SPIRIT OF FEAR AND ANXIETY

2 Timothy 1:7 – For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of a sound mind.

- Thank God that He has uprooted every spirit of fear and anxiety as a church, House on the Rock, London Lighthouse and as individuals.
- Pray in the name of Jesus; we refuse and say no to fear and anxiety, because God has not given us the spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of a sound mind.

Jeremiah 29: 11 – For I know the plans I have for you,” says the Lord. “They are plans for good and not for disaster, to give you a future and a hope.

- Pray that our tomorrow is blessed by God, therefore, all spirits responsible for the fear and anxiety of tomorrow, we bind you in Jesus’ name.
- Pray and rebuke every spirit of fear that tries to undermine God’s love in our lives and as a church, today, tomorrow and in the future in Jesus’ name.

1 John 4:18 – There is no fear in love; but perfect love casts out fear.

1 Corinthians 16:13 – Be on your guard; stand firm in the faith; be courageous; be strong.

- Pray and ask the Lord to fill us with the Spirit of love so that we will not pray from the place of fear and anxiety – for love cast out fear.
- Pray that God will advance us in unwavering faith in Him so that no unbelief will be found in us as we pray.

Philippians 4:6 – Don’t worry about anything; instead, pray about everything. Tell God what you need and thank him for all he has done.

Psalms 94:19 – When anxiety was great within me, your consolation brought me joy.

- Thank God for victory over fear and anxiety.
- Decree that we emerge triumphant over fear and anxiety in the mighty name of Jesus.
- Pray that from henceforth, victory becomes our daily experience in Jesus mighty name.

Isaiah 26:3 – You will keep in perfect peace all who trust in you, all whose thoughts are fixed on you!

Deuteronomy 31:6 – So be strong and courageous! Do not be afraid and do not panic before them. For the Lord your God will personally go ahead of you. He will neither fail you nor abandon you.”

Psalms 27:1 – The Lord is my light and my salvation; Whom shall I fear? The Lord is the strength of my life; Of whom shall I be afraid?

- Pray for the peace of God to flow into our homes, in our church and into that situation as assurance in the place of doubt, fear and anxiety.
- Declare to that obstacle, hindrance, barrier and mountain that there will be calmness in the midst of a storm. Every fear and anxiety is expelled in Jesus mighty name.

- Pray against every form of fear holding us back from advancing in our year of Godspeed. Pray that we will be bold and courageous to take the necessary steps to advance in Jesus' name.

Saturday 28th March 2026

TAKING AUTHORITY OVER TERRITORIAL INFLUENCES (CITY/NATION)

Matthew 16:18 And I tell you that you are Peter, and on this rock I will build my church, and the gates of Hades will not overcome it."

- Declare that our cities and nations would be covered by the unstoppable advance of the Church of Jesus Christ.
- Pray that the Lord is building His Church upon the rock of divine revelation, and that no territorial power, no principality, no stronghold erected over our land shall withstand its advance. We rise with the confidence of those who know the gates of hell are already defeated and march accordingly.

Matthew 16:19 "I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven; whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven."

- Pray that we walk in the full authority of the keys entrusted to us- binding on earth what Heaven has already bound, and loosing on earth what Heaven has already loosed.
- Let's declare that the Lord is placing in our hands the keys of governmental authority over our cities and nations. That we would not leave those keys unused, but would exercise them with boldness, precision, and faith in the courts of Heaven.

- Sharpness of our eyes, we pray, declare that they would be opened to the true nature of the battle over our cities and nations, that we would not war against people but against the powers and principalities that drive them.
- Declare that the Lord is giving us discernment to identify and dismantle the spiritual forces behind the moral, political, and social decay of our land.
- Establish that our intercession would be targeted, informed, and Spirit-led, striking every source of darkness.

Matthew 16:19 "Whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven."

Ephesians 6:12 "Against the rulers, against the authorities, against the powers of this dark world"

- Bind every strongman assigned over our territories -every ruling spirit of corruption, division, idolatry, and deception would be bound in the authority of the name of Jesus Christ.
- Declare that the Lord is identifying for us the principalities that have held our cities and nations captive and is granting us the grace to bind them through unified prayer.
- Pray that as we bind in the earth realm, Heaven would enforce our declarations and the captives would be set free.

Matthew 16:19 "Whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven."

Ephesians 6:12 "Against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms."

- Decree that as we dismantle dark structures in prayer, we would simultaneously loose the Kingdom of God, His righteousness, justice, peace, and order over every sphere of influence in our cities and nations.
- Declare that the Lord is releasing revival, reformation, and the fear of HIM into our territories.
- Declare that every system and structure that the enemy has built in the heavenly realms over our land, would be replaced by the dominion of Christ the King...Hallelujah

Ephesians 6:11 "Put on the full armour of God, so that you can take your stand against the devil's schemes."

Matthew 16:18 "On this rock I will build my church, and the gates of Hades will not overcome it."

- Declare that we would take our position as gatekeepers - dressed in the full armour of God, standing at the gates of our cities and nations as watchmen who will not be moved.
- Declare that the Lord is establishing His Church as a governing body in the spirit, with authority to determine what enters and what is expelled from our territories.
- Ask for strength and focus not to vacate our post, grow weary in intercession and not stop until the kingdoms of this world become the Kingdom of our God and of His Christ in Jesus' mighty name, Amen.

Sunday 29th March 2026

COVERING PASTORS, LEADERS & VISION IN SPIRITUAL ARMOUR

1 Timothy 2: 1-2: Therefore, I exhort first of all, that supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks be made for all men, 2 for kings and all who are in authority, that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and reverence.

- Let us thank God for Pastor Temi, Pastor Abi and all our Pastors and Leaders, let us thank God for the great work He is doing through their lives and ministries.

1 Peter 3:7 "Likewise, ye husbands, dwell with them according to knowledge, giving honour unto the wife, as unto the weaker vessel, and as being heirs together of the grace of life; that your prayers be not hindered."

- Declare the Divine restoration in Marriages, Families and Relationships in HOTR London Lighthouse.

Deuteronomy 30:9-14 "And the LORD thy God will make thee plenteous in every work of thine hand, in the fruit of thy body, and in the fruit of thy cattle, and in the fruit of thy land, for good: for the LORD will again rejoice over thee for good, as he rejoiced over thy fathers: if thou shalt hearken unto the voice of the LORD thy God, to keep his commandments and his statutes which are written in this book of the law, and if thou turn unto the LORD thy God with all thine heart, and with all thy soul. For this commandment which I command thee this day, it is not hidden from

thee, neither is it far off. It is not in heaven, that thou shouldest say, Who shall go up for us to heaven, and bring it unto us, that we may hear it, and do it? - Declaring the Divine restoration in the Life of our children and offspring.

Ezekiel 36:26 “A new heart also will I give you, and a new spirit will I put within you: and I will take away the stony heart out of your flesh, and I will give you a heart of flesh.”

Isaiah 43:19 “Behold, I will do a new thing; now it shall spring forth; shall ye not know it? I will even make a way in the wilderness, and rivers in the desert.”

2 Corinthians 5:18 “And all things are of God, who hath reconciled us to himself by Jesus Christ, and hath given to us the ministry of reconciliation;”

- Declaring the Divine restoration in the body of Christ and HOTR

Joel 2:25 “And I will restore to you the years that the locust hath eaten, the cankerworm, and the caterpillar, and the palmerworm, my great army which I sent among you.”

- Declare multiple fold restoration now and all year round for all the Members of HOTR London Lighthouse.
- Thank God for fully restoring us.

Wednesday 1st April 2026

DECLARING SUPERNATURAL HEALTH & LONGEVITY

Psalms 118:17 "I shall not die, but live, and declare the works of the Lord."

III John 1:2 "Beloved, I pray that you may prosper in all things and be in health, just as your soul prospers."

- Thank God for the precious gift of life and for sustaining us each day.
- Declare according to God's Word that we shall not die but live and declare the works of the Lord.
- Acknowledge that every breath we take comes from God, and give Him praise for the strength and vitality He has given our bodies.
- Thank Him for protecting us from dangers seen and unseen and for preserving our lives up to this day.
- Receive God's promise of life, vitality, and divine preservation, and commit our bodies, minds, and spirits into His hands.

Psalms 103:1-5 "Bless the LORD, O my soul: And all that is within me, bless his holy name. Bless the LORD, O my soul, And forget not all his benefits: Who forgiveth all thine iniquities; Who healeth all thy diseases; Who redeemeth thy life from destruction; Who crowneth thee with lovingkindness and tender mercies; Who satisfieth thy mouth with good things; So that thy youth is renewed like the eagle's."
Acts 17:25 "neither is worshipped with men's hands, as though he needed any thing, seeing he giveth to all life, and breath, and all things;"

- Thank God for His desire that we prosper and be in health even as our souls prosper.
- Declare divine health over our entire bodies.
- Speak life and alignment over every organ, tissue, and system in our bodies, affirming that they function according to the perfect design of God.
- Ask the Lord to let His healing power flow through our bodies and restore anything that is weak, damaged, or out of order.
- Receive by faith the healing made available through the sacrifice of Jesus Christ and declare that we walk in divine health.

Exodus 15:26 "If you diligently heed the voice of the Lord your God and do what is right in His sight, give ear to His commandments and keep all His statutes, I will put none of the diseases on you which I have brought on the Egyptians. For I am the Lord who heals you."

Isaiah 53:5 "But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed."

Jeremiah 30:17 "For I will restore health to you, and your wounds I will heal, declares the LORD, because they have called you an outcast: It is Zion, for whom no one cares!"

- Stand on the Word of God and reject every sickness, disease, and affliction that seeks to attack our bodies.
- Declare that every inherited illness, recurring health issue, and negative medical report that contradicts the promises of God loses its power over our lives.
- Affirm that our bodies are the temple of the Holy Spirit, and therefore sickness has no rightful place in them.
- Declare victory over every work of the enemy and speak healing and restoration over our lives in Jesus' name.

Isaiah 40:29-31" He gives power to the weak, and to those who have no might He increases strength. Even the youths shall faint and be weary, And the young men shall utterly fall, but those who wait on the Lord Shall renew their strength; They shall mount up with wings like eagles, They shall run and not be weary, they shall walk and not faint.

1 Corinthians 6:19-20 "What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost, which is in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own? For ye are bought with a price: therefore, glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's.

Exodus 15:26 "and said, If thou wilt diligently hearken to the voice of the LORD thy God, and wilt do that which is right in his sight, and wilt give ear to his commandments, and keep all his statutes, I will put none of these diseases upon thee, which I have brought upon the Egyptians: for I am the LORD that healeth thee."

Luke 10:19 "Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you."

- Pray for renewed strength in every area of our lives.
- Ask the Lord that when we feel weak, His power will sustain us.
- Pray that God refreshes our bodies, renews our minds, and strengthens our spirits so that we may fulfil the purpose He has for us.
- Declare that our strength will be continually renewed like the eagle's and that we will not grow weary in doing what is good.
- Ask God to help us walk each day in the energy, vitality, and grace that comes from Him.

Isaiah 40:29-31 "He giveth power to the faint; and to them that have no might he increaseth strength. Even the youths shall faint and be weary, and the young men shall utterly fall: but they that wait upon the LORD shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint."

2 Corinthians 4:16 "For which cause we faint not; but though our outward man perish, yet the inward man is renewed day by day."

Psalms 91:16 "With long life I will satisfy him and show him My salvation."

Psalms 92:12-14 "The righteous shall flourish like the palm tree: He shall grow like a cedar in Lebanon. Those that be planted in the house of the LORD Shall flourish in the courts of our God. They shall still bring forth fruit in old age; They shall be fat and flourishing;"

- Stand on the promise of God that with long life He will satisfy us and show us His salvation.
- Declare that our days will not be cut short and that we will live to fulfil every assignment God has given us.
- Pray for divine preservation from accidents, sudden illness, and every form of danger.
- Ask the Lord to command His angels to watch over us and keep us in all our ways.
- Declare that we will enjoy the fullness of the years that God has ordained for our lives.

Psalms 118:17 "I shall not die, but live, and declare the works of the Lord."

Psalms 91:16 "With long life will I satisfy him and shew him my salvation."

Proverbs 3:1-2 "My son, forget not my law; But let thine heart keep my commandments: For length of days, and long life, and peace, shall they add to thee."

Isaiah 65:20-22 "There shall be no more thence an infant of days, nor an old man that hath not filled his days: for the child shall die an hundred years old; but the sinner being a hundred years old shall be accursed. And they shall build houses and inhabit them; and they shall plant vineyards and eat the fruit of them. They shall not build, and another inhabit; they shall not plant, and another eat: for as the days of a tree are the days of my people, and mine elect shall long enjoy the work of their hands."

- Thank God for the gift of health and long life.
- Pray for the grace to use our lives to honour and serve the Lord.
- Ask that our bodies become instruments of righteousness and that our lives reflect the goodness of God.

- Pray that the strength and years God gives us will be used to bless others, serve His Kingdom, and declare His works in our generation.
- Declare that our lives will reflect God's glory and draw many people closer to Him.

Psalm 118:17 "I shall not die, but live, and declare the works of the LORD."

Matthew 5:6 "Blessed are they which do hunger and thirst after righteousness: for they shall be filled."

Philippians 1:21 "For to me to live is Christ, and to die is gain."

Thursday 2nd April 2026

DECLARING OPEN DOORS & UNCOMMON FAVOUR

Psalm 136:1–3 – "O give thanks unto the Lord; for he is good: for his mercy endures forever. O give thanks unto the God of gods: for his mercy endures forever. O give thanks to the Lord of lords: for his mercy endures for ever."

- Thank God for His goodness, mercy, and faithfulness over our lives. Appreciate Him for the doors He has already opened and for the favour we have already experienced.
- Thank Him for every opportunity, every testimony, and every breakthrough He has granted us. Bless Him because He is the God who makes ways where there seems to be no way and who positions His people for favour and advancement.

Revelation 3:8 – "I know thy works: behold, I have set before thee an open door, and no man can shut it: for thou hast a little strength, and hast kept my word, and hast not denied my name."

- Pray that God will release divinely appointed open doors in every area of your life. Ask God to open doors of opportunity, progress, and advancement that no human power can shut.
- Declare that every door that God has ordained for us in this season will open speedily.
- Pray that barriers, delays, and spiritual opposition that stand before these doors will be removed by the power of God.

Revelation 4:1 – "After this I looked, and, behold, a door was opened in heaven: and the first voice which I heard was as it were of a trumpet talking with me; which said, come up hither, and I will shew thee things which must be hereafter."

- Pray that heavenly doors will open over our lives, families, and the Church.
- Ask for divine access to new levels, new opportunities, and greater dimensions of God's purpose.
- Declare that the Lord will usher us into places of influence, growth, and divine elevation.
- Pray that this season will bring supernatural opportunities that only God can orchestrate.

Psalm 5:12 – “For thou, Lord, wilt bless the righteous; with favour wilt thou compass him as with a shield.”

- Pray that the favour of God will surround us like a shield.
- Ask that God's favour will protect, promote, and position us for success.
- Declare that every rejection, limitation, and delay will be overturned by divine favour.
- Pray that wherever we go, the favour of God will speak for us and open doors that human effort alone cannot open.

Revelation 4:1 – “The Lord hath been mindful of us: he will bless us; he will bless the house of Israel; he will bless the house of Aaron. He will bless them that fear the Lord, both small and great. The Lord shall increase you more and more, you and your children.”

- Thank God for the open doors and favour He has already prepared for us.
- Thank Him because every door He opens cannot be shut by anyone. Appreciate Him for the testimonies and breakthroughs that will follow.
- Celebrate Him because His favour will continually speak over our lives.
- Thank Him because this season will be marked by open doors, divine opportunities, and uncommon favour.

Friday 3rd April 2026

DECLARING EXPLOSIVE GROWTH & KINGDOM EXPANSION

Isaiah 2:2–3 "In the last days the mountain of the Lord's temple will be established... and all nations will stream to it."

Isaiah 60:1–3 "Arise, shine; for thy light has come, and the glory of the Lord is risen upon thee... and kings to the brightness of thy rising."

- Let us begin by thanking God for His promise to establish His Kingdom in the earth and for the privilege of being part of His divine agenda in this generation.

Matthew 16:18 “And I say also unto thee, that thou art Peter, and upon this rock I will build my church; and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it.”

Acts 2:47 “praising God and having favour with all the people. And the Lord added to the church daily such as should be saved.”

- Thank God for the growth, testimonies, and impact He has already brought to His Church.
- Celebrate the lives that have been transformed and the souls that have been brought into the Kingdom.

Isaiah 2:2-3 “And it shall come to pass in the last days, that the mountain of the LORD's house shall be established in the top of the mountains, and shall be exalted above the hills; and all nations shall flow unto it. And many people shall go and say, Come ye, and let us go up to the mountain of the LORD, to the house of the God of Jacob; and he will teach us of his ways, and we will walk in his paths: for out of Zion shall go forth the law, and the word of the LORD from Jerusalem.”

- Let us declare that according to Isaiah 2:2–3, the house of the Lord will be established and exalted, and the Church will experience supernatural growth and expansion.

Isaiah 60:1-3 “Arise, shine; for thy light is come, and the glory of the LORD is risen upon thee. For, behold, the darkness shall cover the earth, and gross darkness the people: but the LORD shall arise upon thee, and his glory shall be seen upon thee. And the Gentiles shall come to thy light, and kings to the brightness of thy rising.”

- Pray that multitudes will be drawn to the light of Christ shining through the Church and that people from different nations and communities will encounter God's presence.

Matthew 5:14-16 “Ye are the light of the world. A city that is set on an hill cannot be hid. Neither do men light a candle, and put it under a bushel, but on a candlestick; and it giveth light unto all that are in the house. Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven.”

- Declare that the glory of the Lord will arise upon His people and that the light of Christ will shine brightly through the Church even in the midst of darkness.

Acts 6:7 “And the word of God increased; and the number of the disciples multiplied in Jerusalem greatly; and a great company of the priests were obedient to the faith.”

- Pray for explosive spiritual growth among believers—growth in prayer, the Word, holiness, and the power of the Holy Spirit.

Habakkuk 2:14 “For the earth shall be filled with the knowledge of the glory of the LORD, as the waters cover the sea.”

- Ask God to release divine strategies, wisdom, and resources that will enable the Church to expand its reach and impact communities and nations.

Mark 16:15 “And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature.”

- Declare that evangelism will be effective and fruitful and that many souls will come to the knowledge of Christ through the preaching of the Gospel.

Philippians 2:15 “that ye may be blameless and harmless, the sons of God, without rebuke, in the midst of a crooked and perverse nation, among whom ye shine as lights in the world;”

- Pray that the Church will become a beacon of hope, truth, and transformation in society.
- Decree that the Kingdom of God advances in every sphere of influence—families, communities, government, education, business, and culture.

Psalms 110:3 “Thy people shall be willing in the day of thy power, In the beauties of holiness from the womb of the morning: Thou hast the dew of thy youth.”

- Thank God for the season of explosive growth, supernatural expansion, and global Kingdom impact.

**Saturday 4th April 2026
DECLARING HOUSEHOLD SALVATION**

Ephesians 2:8–9 For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God— not by works, so that no one can boast.

- Let us thank God for the gift of salvation through Jesus Christ as we also thank God for drawing us into His kingdom by His grace.
- Pray to appreciate God for His mercy over your family members nuclear and extended.
- Let's pray and acknowledge that salvation is God's desire for every household.

Acts 16:31 They replied, "Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved—you and your household."

- As the Philippian Jailer and his entire household were saved after a divine encounter in Acts of the Apostles 16:25–34; let us pray for every unsaved member of our household today and declare that they encounter Jesus Christ personally.
- Let us pray that hearts that are hardened toward the gospel will be softened and be made readily available to receive the Gospel.
- Let us pray that God will create divine moments that will lead family members to salvation.
- Pray to declare God's promise of salvation over your household.

2 Corinthians 4:4 "The god of this age has blinded the minds of unbelievers, so that they cannot see the light of the gospel that displays the glory of Christ, who is the image of God."

- As Saul's spiritual blindness was removed after his encounter with Jesus Christ, leading to his transformation in the Acts of the Apostles 9:1–18, let's pray that every spiritual blindness hindering our loved ones from receiving Christ will be removed.
- Pray against generational patterns, designs and influences that oppose salvation, as we pray for freedom from destructive lifestyles and wrong associations.
- Let us pray for divine intervention that will redirect the lives of family members.

Matthew 5:16 Let your light shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your Father in heaven.

- Pray for grace to demonstrate Christ-like character and behaviour within your household to become an example of the believer in your home.
- Let us pray for the wisdom of God in sharing the gospel with love and patience.

Malachi 4:6 “He will turn the hearts of the parents to their children, and the hearts of the children to their parents; or else I will come and strike the land with total destruction.”

- As Jacob’s family experienced reconciliation after years of separation and conflict, let us pray for the healing of broken relationships within families.
- Let’s pray for the restoration of love, unity, and mutual understanding amongst members of the family.
- Let’s pray against conflicts, resentment, and long-standing divisions that have plagued families in the HOTR London Lighthouse.

Joshua 24:15 But as for me and my household, we will serve the Lord.

- Pray for a firm spiritual foundation to be established in your home and enthrone the culture of prayer, worship, and obedience to God’s Word.
- Let’s pray for the Children and the future generations in our family to walk in the way and the fear of the Lord.

Psalms 126:3 The Lord has done great things for us, and we are filled with joy.

- Finally, let us pray, thanking God in faith for the salvation of every member of our household and believing God for testimonies that will emerge from these prayers.
- Let’s thank God for establishing His covenant in your family line.

- Let us thank God for the finished work of the cross that secured our victory in all ramifications of our lives.

1 Corinthians 15:57 “But thanks be to God, which giveth us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.”

- Let us give thanks to the Father for setting us free from every legal indebtedness due to sin.

Colossians 2:14 “blotting out the handwriting of ordinances that was against us, which was contrary to us, and took it out of the way, nailing it to his cross;”

- Let's pray that God, by His Spirit within us, would open the eyes of our understanding to grasp, appreciate and appropriate the finished work of the Cross
