



August 2026 PUSH Prayer Bulletin

***“Then I proclaimed a fast there, at the river of Ahava,
that we might afflict ourselves before our God, to seek of him a right way
for us, and for our little ones,
and for all our substance... So, we fasted and besought our God for this:
and he was intreated of us”
Ezra 8:21, 23***

Day 1 - Thanksgiving for and declaring the overflow

Psalm 23:5 - "Thou anointest my head with oil; my cup runneth over."

- Let's thank our Father that He has not only met us at the point of need but seated us at a prepared table. Thank Him for the anointing that has not run dry and the cup that has never stopped filling, even in the midst of opposition. We are thanking Him that our cup runs over. That what He has poured into our lives exceeds that which our season demanded, and the overflow spills onto everyone connected to us.

Psalm 65:11 - "Thou crownest the year with thy goodness; and thy paths drop fatness."

- Let us give God thanks for His goodness that has followed us month by month - the answered prayers, the quiet provisions, the doors we did not have to force open. Thank Him for this month He has chosen to crown, that wherever our feet go, abundance drops. Thank Him that our paths are wet with the fatness of Abba Father.

Philippians 4:19 - But my God shall supply all your need according to his riches in glory by Christ Jesus."

Father, we thank You because our supply is according to Your riches. Thank You for supernatural provision and for meeting every need in the month of August.

Ephesians 3:20 - Now unto him that is able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that worketh in us."

Father, we praise You in advance for seeing the manifestations that will exceed our prayers, plans and expectations.

Psalm 44:3 - For they got not the land in possession by their own sword, neither did their own arm save them: but thy right hand, and thine arm, and the light of thy countenance, because thou hadst a favour unto them."

Father, thank You for the overflow of Your favour. We acknowledge that it is not merely our strength, intelligence, connections or effort. Your favour has brought us this far, and Your favour will take us further.

John 6:11–13 - And Jesus took the loaves; and when he had given thanks, he distributed to the disciples... When they were filled, he said unto his disciples, Gather up the fragments that remain, that nothing be lost... and filled twelve baskets..."

Father - we give thanks for multiplication and supernatural increase. Let little become much; let insufficiency become abundance; and let what begins as provision end in overflow—with baskets remaining.

Psalm 65:11 - Thou crownest the year with thy goodness; and thy paths drop fatness."

Father, we thank you and declare that we will not merely hear about overflow—we will see it, experience it, carry it and become channels of it.

Day 2 - Rejecting the Scarcity Mindset.

Romans 12 v 2 - *Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is—his good, pleasing and perfect will.*

- Let us pray for a renewal of mindset. That our mindset is renewed continuously and that we think plenty always instead of scarcity. Pray that our thinking does not conform to scarcity as the world thinks.

Phil 4 v 19 - And my God shall supply all your need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus.

- Let us pray that there is an abundance of provision. That we have the right mindset of more than enough. That our mindset is unblocked from the scarcity mindset.

Psalm 1 v 3 - And he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that bringeth forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither; and whatsoever he doeth shall prosper.

- Pray for the correct positioning of our minds. That as we reject the mindset of scarcity, our minds will be transformed into the mindset of always “having” in season and out of season.

1 Cor 2 v 16 - For who hath known the mind of the Lord, that he should instruct him? But we have the mind of Christ.

- Pray that the mind of Christ will be in us. That we reject every scarcity mindset but rather our minds are that of Christ our God. As the mind of Christ does not think scarcity so also does our minds think as well.

Proverbs 10 v 22 - The blessing of the Lord brings wealth, without painful toil for it."

- Having a mindset of scarcity is not of God. Let us reject the scarcity mindset and pray that our minds will begin to see and comprehend the might and wealth of our Father. That our minds begin to understand that we are truly blessed.

Deut 8 v 18 - But remember the Lord your God, for it is he who gives you the ability to produce wealth, and so confirms his covenant, which he swore to your ancestors, as it is today."

- Pray that our minds will always remember the promises of God and look towards it instead. That it would always reject scarcity thinking even when it is what the world is saying.

Day 3 - WARFARE AGAINST ALL THAT OPPOSE OUR OVERFLOW

"Thou anointest my head with oil; my cup runneth over." Psalm 23:5

- Let us begin by declaring that our portion is not limitation, but overflow. Pray that everything God has ordained for our lives shall come into its fullness, and that no power, principality, circumstance or opposition will prevent us from entering the abundance that God has prepared for us. Let us declare that our cups shall not merely be filled, but shall run over - that our lives, families, finances, ministries, careers and the work of our hands will testify of the goodness of the Lord. Father, take us beyond barely enough into the place of divine abundance, fruitfulness and supernatural increase, in Jesus' mighty name.

“For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds.” 2 Corinthians 10:4

- Let us engage in spiritual warfare against every stronghold that has stood between us and our overflow. Pray against every pattern of repeated disappointment, stagnation, near-success, financial frustration, missed opportunities and unexplainable setbacks. Let every stronghold that has resisted our advancement be pulled down by the mighty power of God. We declare that every invisible wall around our progress is coming down, every spiritual barrier is being dismantled, and every limitation that has restricted our capacity to experience God's fullness is broken. Let the power of the Holy Spirit give us victory over every resistance in Jesus' mighty name.

“And I will restore to you the years that the locust hath eaten...” Joel 2:25

- Let us pray for supernatural restoration. Father, restore every opportunity that was lost, every resource that was wasted, every door that was missed, every season that was consumed, and everything that the enemy has attempted to steal from our lives. Pray that the Lord will restore not merely what was lost, but that He will cause restoration to come with increase, multiplication and greater glory. Let us declare that our past losses will not determine our future. The years that appeared wasted shall produce testimonies. The seasons that appeared empty shall become fruitful. What the enemy meant for loss, God shall turn into a testimony, in Jesus' mighty name.

“Behold, I have set before thee an open door, and no man can shut it.” Revelation 3:8

- Let us pray for the opening of divine doors. Father, open every door that You have ordained for our lives and give us the grace and wisdom to walk through those doors. Pray for doors of favour, doors of opportunity, doors of advancement, doors of financial increase, doors of strategic relationships, doors of divine connections, doors of promotion and doors of influence. Let every door that God has opened remain open, and let every power attempting to shut what God has opened be defeated. We declare that this is not a season of closed doors but of divine access. What God has ordained for us will locate us, and no man will be able to stop it.

“And God is able to make all grace abound toward you; that ye, always having all sufficiency in all things, may abound to every good work.” 2 Corinthians 9:8

- Let us pray for grace for overflow. Pray that God will take us beyond insufficiency into all sufficiency, and from sufficiency into abundance for every good work. Father, increase our capacity to receive, manage and multiply what You place in our hands. Give us wisdom to steward our resources, opportunities and relationships. Let there be an overflow of grace, wisdom, favour, resources, ideas, opportunities, peace and spiritual strength. We declare that we shall have enough not only for ourselves but enough to be a blessing to others. Our lives shall become channels through which the goodness of God flows.

“Enlarge the place of thy tent, and let them stretch forth the curtains of thine habitations: spare not, lengthen thy cords, and strengthen thy stakes.” Isaiah 54:2

- Let us pray for capacity for our overflow. Pray that God will enlarge us internally before He enlarges us externally. Let the Lord increase our capacity for responsibility, influence, resources, leadership and blessing. Pray that we will not remain mentally, spiritually or practically confined to the dimensions of our past. Let every small expectation be enlarged. Let every limited vision be expanded. Let us declare that we are making room for what God is bringing into our lives. We will not allow yesterday's limitations to define tomorrow's possibilities. Our tents are being enlarged, our cords are being stretched, and our stakes are being strengthened.

“Then shall the plowman overtake the reaper, and the treader of grapes him that soweth seed...” Amos 9:13

- Let us pray for an acceleration of harvest. Father, bring us into a season where the results of our labour begin to manifest with unusual speed. Pray that what has taken years to produce will begin to yield fruit according to Your appointed timing. Let there be divine acceleration concerning our prayers, opportunities, contracts, businesses, finances, careers, family breakthroughs and testimonies. Let us declare that we are entering a season where harvest will overtake sowing. The things we have prayed for, worked for and trusted God for shall begin to manifest in ways that can only be attributed to the hand of God.
